

GETTING AROUND



OC TRANSPO

OC Transpo (octranspo1.com) is Ottawa's bus and light rail transit system. With Regular, Express and Rural routes spanning all of Ottawa, OC Transpo is an efficient and affordable method of public transportation. They offer one way, daily, monthly and yearly passes to fit your schedule and budget.

Download the MyTransit app to get up to date schedules, trip planner, live updates, interactive maps, favourite routes and more.



TAXI! TAXI!

Ottawa has many independent companies offering taxi services to Ottawans. Blueline Taxi (bluelinetaxi.com) and Capital Taxi (capitaltaxi.com) have two of the largest fleets of taxi cabs in Ottawa and are a good place to start. We recommend calling for a taxi - they are often hard to come by on the street!



UBER/RIDE-ORDERING

Uber (www.uber.com) is a private transportation company that offers affordable rides, complete with fare estimates before booking, at the click of a button. To use Uber, you must download the app on your mobile device or visit the website to set up an account and link a form of payment. Once set up, you will be able to request a ride and receive notifications when your ride is on it's way!



CAPITAL BIXI

Capital BIXI (capital.bixi.com) is a bicycle rental company with pick up and drop off stations all across Ottawa. With a small subscription fee, BIXI bikes are by far the most economical short distance method of getting around Ottawa.

ARTS & CULTURE



NATIONAL ARTS CENTRE

The National Arts Centre is Canada's foremost showcase for the performing arts. It was established by parliament in the 1960s as a centennial project and opened its doors in 1969. The NAC is an innovator in every one of its performing arts' fields, including classical music, English theatre, French theatre, dance, variety, and community programming. It is the only multidisciplinary, bilingual performing arts centre in North America. There truly is something for everyone.



CANADIAN TIRE CENTRE

When it's not the home venue for the Ottawa Senators, Canadian Tire Centre is home to many concerts and other shows, with a seating capacity of over 18,500. With its suite rentals and variety of restaurants, it is truly a venue for all budgets and interests.



CANADIAN MUSEUM OF NATURE

The recently renovated Canadian Museum of Nature contains exhibits that demonstrate that nature touches every aspect of our lives. With the first phase of its renewal project completed, it is a natural history museum with brand new, breathtaking exhibits, including Fossils, Mammals, Birds, and the Discovery Zone.



CANADIAN MUSEUM OF CIVILIZATION

The Canadian Museum of Civilization includes the Canadian Children's Museum, the Canadian Postal Museum, and an IMAX theatre. Its IMAX theatre was the first theatre in the world to host both an IMAX screen as well as an IMAX dome. Permanent exhibits at the Canadian Museum of Civilization include The Grand Hall, The First People's Hall, The Canada Hall, and Face to Face: The Canadian Personalities Hall.



CANADA SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY MUSEUM



FESTIVALS



WINTERLUDE

Every February, Ottawa-Gatineau holds Winterlude, a winter celebration that features breath-taking ice sculptures, ice carving competitions, skating along the world's longest skating rink, live entertainment, snow playgrounds, and outdoor dance parties.



CANADIAN TULIP FESTIVAL

Every May, the Canadian Tulip Festival (tulipfestival.ca) highlights the city with a variety of colours as millions of tulips take bloom in this world-famous festival. The largest displays can be found in Commissioners Park, near Dow's Lake, and along the Rideau Canal. Also offered are family activities, live entertainment, fireworks and much more.



WESTFEST

Every June, over 50,000 people attend Westfest (westfest.ca), a free outdoor music, art and life showcase for Canadian artists and their work. Westfest fills 14 city blocks with a variety of contemporary art, visual art, media art, performance art, spoken word, children's entertainment, buskers and much more.



OTTAWA JAZZ FESTIVAL

Every June, the TD Ottawa Jazz Festival (ottawajazzfestival.com) offers a diverse line up of talented artists, over eleven days, and is considered one of the world's greatest music festivals.



BLUESFEST

Every July, Bluesfest (ottawabluesfest.ca) attracts a world class selection of musicians to play 10 days worth of shows on multiple stages in the Downtown area of Ottawa. Music genres include a variety, with headliners from Pop, Country, Rock, Hip-Hop/Rap, Blues, Indie and more.



CITYFOLK FESTIVAL

MAKING AN OFFER

In negotiating the purchase of your new home, the initial step will be to instruct your Buyer Sales Representative to make an Offer to Purchase. This offer must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit cheque to show good faith.

The major elements of an offer include:

- Legal Names of Buyers and Sellers;
- Legal Description of the property;
- Price the amount you are willing to pay.
 Depending on the local market conditions, your opinion of value and market information provided by your realtor, the price you offer may be different from the seller's asking price;
- Amount of Deposit: The deposit shows your good faith and will be applied against the purchase of the home when the sale closes. Your realtor can advise you on an appropriate amount, usually between \$1,000 to \$5,000;
- List of Terms and Conditions: this might include items such as obtaining financing, obtaining a satisfactory building inspection, or subject to selling your existing property;
- List of Fixtures and Chattels that are included and excluded. These might include appliances and certain fixtures or decorative items, such as window coverings or mirrors, or appliances such as fridge, stove;
- Closing/Occupancy date: Generally, the day the title of the property is legally transferred and the transaction of funds finalized unless otherwise specified.

MOVING CHECKLIST

6 WEEKS BEFORE YOU MOVE

- Decide what must go (i.e. books you've never read or will never read again, old clothing, etc).
- Contact moving companies for estimates it's a good idea to obtain estimates from several movers.
- Start a file to record details of the move.
- Begin gathering the boxes you will need for your stuff

4 WEEKS BEFORE YOU MOVE

- Go to the post office and obtain a change of address form.
- Call your utility companies to notify them of your change of address.
- Complete any repair work on your old home and arrange for critical services at your new home.
- Start packing items that are seldom used (ie. Fine china, out of season clothing, art, photos, decor items).

3 WEEKS BEFORE YOU MOVE

- Start your serious packing, room by room.
- Box essential items together.
- Plan your food purchases in order to have as little as possible in the fridge and freezer on moving day.
- Arrange to have your new home cleaned, as close to move in time as possible.
- Have a garage sale to get rid of any unwanted items before it's too late.

2 WEEKS BEFORE YOU MOVE

- Cancel current insurance coverage and transfer. coverage to your new home (watch effective dates).
- Make special arrangements for transporting your pets and house plants.
- Transfer prescriptions to a pharmacy in your new neighbourhood.
- Meet with your bank to change your address and arrange for account transfers.

1 WEEK BEFORE YOU MOVE

- Ensure arrangements have been made to disconnect and service your major appliances that are being moved.
- Pick up laundry at dry cleaners and return borrowed items such as library books.
- Pack your own suitcase of clothes for the move.
- Pay outstanding bills and be sure to indicate.
 your new address on payment receipts.
- Call your lawyer and mortgage contact to ensure everything is on track for closing.
- Cancel newspaper and magazine subscriptions.

1-2 DAYS BEFORE YOU MOVE

- If you are using movers, they'll arrive to start the packing process.
- Empty and defrost your fridge and freezer, clean them with a disinfectant and let them air out.
- Empty your safety deposit box.
- Leave your forwarding address and phone number for your home's new occupants.
- If your house will remain vacant, notify policy and neighbours.

MOVING DAY

- Remove linens from the beds and pack in an "open first" box.
- Give the home a final cleaning.
- Review all details and paperwork with movers when they arrive.
- Check to make sure the utilities have been connected and follow up on any delays.
- Confine your pets to an out-of-the-way room to help keep them from getting in the way during the move.
- One person should check off inventory sheets as items are unloaded, while a second mover directs movers.
